



INVITATION TO BID

Burn Assist 2026

RECEIPT OF BIDS: Sealed bids for the Shasta Valley Resource Conservation District (SVRCD) Burn Assistance 2026 Project will be received by the Shasta Valley Resource Conservation District acting for CAL FIRE and the State of California. Sealed bids must be received at the following address by **September 15, 2026**, at or before **2:00 pm**:

OBTAINING BID DOCUMENTS: Copies of the Bid Packet may be obtained on or after **August 28, 2026**. Bid documents can be found at the SVRCD website at <http://www.svrcd.org/contracting>.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: This contract is being executed by the Shasta Valley Resource Conservation District using California Climate Investment/CAL FIRE Forest Health Program funding to implement broadcast burning within Siskiyou County, California. The project solicits proposals from qualified Contractors to furnish various sized modules (crews)/workday lengths to accomplish both prescribed burn preparation actions and prescribed fire implementation. The work will be located on privately owned properties.

Multiple Contractors may be awarded under this solicitation and requested at the time of need under separate Task Orders. Task Orders may be ordered from the date of award of this contract until July 1, 2027.

PROJECT TIMELINE:

- Bid Packet Released August 28, 2026
- Bids Due September 15, 2026 at 2 pm
- Contract award by September 25, 2026
- Contract termination is July 1, 2027

CONTRACTOR EXPERIENCE: This project requires that the contractor is experienced in performing prescribed fire preparation and implementation work. References for similar projects may be requested as determined by the SVRCD Project Manager.

CONTRACTOR OBLIGATIONS, LICENSING AND REGISTRATIONS: Contractor agrees to be bound by all the provisions of the California State Labor code and shall monitor all contracts subject to reimbursement from this Agreement.

PRE-BID SITE VISIT: There will be no pre-bid site visit. For the purposes of informing accurate bid development, the four project area locations are identified on the map included with the bid packet.
