RECEIPT OF BIDS: Sealed bids for implementation of the Tennant Fire Restoration Project will be received by the Shasta Valley Resource Conservation District. OBTAINING BID DOCUMENTS: Copies of the BID DOCUMENTS may be obtained on or after **August 28, 2026**. Bid documents can be found at the SVRCD office. If you plan to obtain bid documents before or at the pre-bid tour, please email Shannon Mason, Project Coordinator, at smason@svrccd.org to give notification of your interest in doing so.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: The Tennant Fire Restoration Project will reduce hazardous fuels in the burn scar of the Antelope Fire. Treatments will include mechanical or manual removal of hazardous vegetation and dead trees over 26 to 40 acres. Mechanical operations will include the use of a feller buncher and/or a masticator if applicable. Cut material will be machine-piled. The project goals include community protection, fuel reduction, and safety.

Funding for this project is provided by a grant from the US Forest Service to the California Association of Resource Conservation Districts (CARCD).

Contractors may bid on all items listed or only a portion of the project.

PROJECT TIMELINE:

- Bid Packet Released August 28, 2026
- Pre-Bid Site Visit September 9, 2026 at 9:00am
- Bids Due September 16, 2026 at 2:00pm
- Contract award by September 24, 2026
- All activities must be completed by November 15, 2026

CONTRACTOR EXPERIENCE: This project requires that the contractor is experienced in performing forestry work. References for similar projects may be requested as determined by the SVRCD Project Manager.

CONTRACTOR OBLIGATIONS, LICENSING AND REGISTRATIONS: Contractor agrees to be bound by all the provisions of the California State Labor code regarding prevailing wages and shall monitor all contracts subject to reimbursement from this Agreement. The Contractor must be a Licensed Timber Operator for the State of California.

PRE-BID SITE VISIT: Contractors wishing to bid on this project may attend a pre-site visit on **September 9, 2026 at 9:00am**. Please contact Shannon Mason at the email address above to confirm their attendance. Contractors will meet with Shasta Valley RCD staff in the mailbox area on Tennant Road at the entrance to the community.

ADDRESS AND MARKING OF BID: The envelope enclosing the bid shall be sealed and addressed to the **Shasta Valley RCD (SVRCD)** and delivered or mailed to **215 Executive Ct., Suite B, Yreka CA 96097** no later than **2:00 pm on September 16, 2026**. The envelope shall be plainly marked in the upper left-hand corner with the name and address of the bidder and shall bear the words "Bid for Tennant Fire Restoration Project-Mechanical Contract" and the date. Electronic bids shall be sent to Shannon Mason, Project Coordinator at smason@svrccd.org. Please make the subject line "Bid for the Tennant Fire Restoration Project-Mechanical Contract" followed by your company's name.
